

**Consultation on Admissions Policy 2021/22
October 5th - November 16th 2020**

Dear Consultee,

In September 2022 the new fifth form of entry introduced to Sir William Borlase's Grammar School in 2020 will have worked its way through to year 9. As of the consultation in 2020, at this point the school will no longer operate the previous PAN of 25 new students into year 9 as the additional 30 (plus the 120) from Year 7 2020 will be moving through into year 9.

(From the Admissions consultation for 2020)

“In discussion with our Governing Body and Marlow Education Trust, we have made the decision to make an application for expansion funding from the Department for Education to move from four to five forms of entry. This would mean an initial intake of an extra 30 pupils into Year 7 in 2020 and a further 30 would join Year 7 in 2021, increasing the number of pupils overall by 60. We already have 5 forms in Years 9 - 11 with 145 students in each year group. Therefore as the new 5 forms work their way through the school, years 9-11 will increase by 5 pupils each.”
